To better serve those affected by the Marshall Fire, CCEF and Elevations Credit Union have designed a new process specifically to serve those seeking to add solar PV to their rebuild during construction. By making adjustments to their underwriting criteria, fire victims can take advantage of this targeted product to install solar as their home is being rebuilt while enjoying the same low interest-rates offered through RENU.
